With its soothing Art Deco influenced interiors including natural materials like pearl and velvet, the rooms offer a cosy pied-à-terre for travellers desiring proximity to the city centre and shopping areas. Our favourite is the junior suite, with its romantic beamed ceiling and separate living area.
